Subject- Hindi

निर्देश: सभी कार्य A4 साइज शीट पर करें। सुंदर अक्षरों में लिखें और रंगों का प्रयोग करें। कार्य स्वयं करें।

1. वर्णमाला तितली

रंगीन कागज से एक बड़ी तितली बनाओ। उसके एक पंख पर 'क' से 'ड' तक और दूसरे पंख पर 'च' से 'ज' तक व्यंजन लिखो। हर व्यंजन से एक चित्र बनाओ। जैसे 'क' से कमल।

2. मेरा परिचय फलावर बुक

एक फूल बनाओ। बीच में अपना नाम लिखो। हर पंखुड़ी पर एक जानकारी लिखो: कक्षा, आयु, प्रिय रंग, प्रिय फल, प्रिय खेल। हर पंखुड़ी में चित्र भी बनाओ।

3. संज्ञा की रेलगाड़ी

एक रेलगाड़ी बनाओ जिसमें 3 डिब्बे हों: व्यक्ति, स्थान, वस्तु। हर डिब्बे में 5-5 संज्ञा शब्द के चित्र बनाकर नाम लिखो। जैसे व्यक्ति - अध्यापक।

4. विलोम शब्द सूरजमुखी

एक सूरजमुखी का फूल बनाओ। बीच में एक शब्द लिखो और हर पंखुड़ी पर उसका विलोम शब्द लिखो। 3 सूरजमुखी बनाओ। जैसे: अच्छा - बुरा, दिन - रात, सच - झूठ।

5. कविता चित्र कथा

अपनी हिंदी पुस्तक से कोई 1 कविता चुनो। उसे सुंदर लिखो। कविता के भाव को दिखाते हुए 2-3 चित्र बनाओ। चारों ओर बॉर्डर बनाकर सजाओ।

6. लिंग बदलो जोड़ी

पुराने कार्ड से 10 पत्ते काटो। 5 पत्तों पर पुल्लिंग शब्द का चित्र बनाओ, 5 पर उसका स्त्रीलिंग रूप। इन्हें जोड़ी बनाकर चिपकाओ। जैसे: लड़का - लड़की, राजा - रानी।

7. मेरा सपनों का घर

अपने सपनों के घर का चित्र बनाओ। घर के अलग-अलग हिस्सों के नाम हिंदी में लिखो: दरवाजा, खिड़की, छत, बगीचा। 5 पंक्तियाँ लिखो कि तुम्हें ऐसा घर क्यों पसंद है।

8. पर्यायवाची शब्द माला

रंगीन कागज से फूल काटकर एक माला बनाओ। हर फूल पर एक शब्द और उसके 2 पर्यायवाची शब्द लिखो। 5 फूल की माला बनाओ। जैसे: जल - पानी, नीर।

9. कहानी का थैला

एक कागज का थैला बनाओ। उस पर अपनी मनपसंद कहानी का नाम और एक चित्र बनाओ। थैले के अंदर उस कहानी के 3 मुख्य पात्रों के नाम लिखकर उनके चित्र बनाओ।

10. क्रिया का बगीचा

एक बगीचा बनाओ। बगीचे में काम करते हुए लोगों के 5 चित्र बनाओ। हर चित्र के नीचे क्रिया शब्द लिखो। जैसे: लड़का दौड़ रहा है, माली पानी दे रहा है।

सामग्री: चार्ट पेपर, स्केच पेन, गोंद, कैंची, पुरानी पत्रिकाएँ।

नोट: माता-पिता बच्चों की सहायता कर सकते हैं, परंतु कार्य बच्चे स्वयं करें।

Theme: Become a Junior Scientist

1. My Backyard Safari Journal Adaptation & Habitat

Task: Spend 15 mins every week in your balcony, garden, or nearby park.

- Spot 5 insects/birds/animals. Draw them, write where you saw them, what they were doing, and 1 special body part that helps them live there.

- Example: Ant → 6 legs + strong jaws to carry food.

2. Kitchen Lab: Sprout House Germination & Food

Task: Grow chana/moong in a cotton box.

- Day 1, 3, 5, 7: Draw what you see + measure height with a scale.

- Bonus: Try 3 boxes - one in the sun, one in the dark, one without water. Which grows best? Why?

3. Water Saver Detective Water & Environment

Task: For 1 week, track how your family uses water.

- Make a chart: Bathing, Washing, Drinking, Wasting/Leaks.

- Think of 3 new ways to save water at home. Try them and write what changed.

4. Shadow Tracker Sun, Light & Shadows

Task: On a sunny day, place a stick in the ground.

- Mark the tip of the shadow at 9 AM, 12 PM, 3 PM, 5 PM.

- Draw the shadow pattern. Why does it change? What does this tell you about the Sun?

5. Trash to Treasure Model Solids & Recycling

Task: Pick any 1 Science topic from Class IV - like Types of Houses or Parts of a Plant.

Build a 3D model using only waste materials: boxes, bottles, old newspapers, etc.

Label 3 parts and write 2 lines about it.

6. Family Food Chart Food & Digestion

Task: Interview 3 family members.

Ask: What did you eat yesterday? Sort it into Energy-giving, Body-building, Protective foods.

Find out: Who has the most balanced diet?

7. Weather Watch Reporter Air & Weather

Task: For 7 days, note the weather at 5 PM daily.

- Sunny/Cloudy/Rainy, Hot/Cold, Windy/Calm.

- Make a chart and present a Weather Report to your family like on TV.

8. Read one page daily and write difficult words in capital copy.

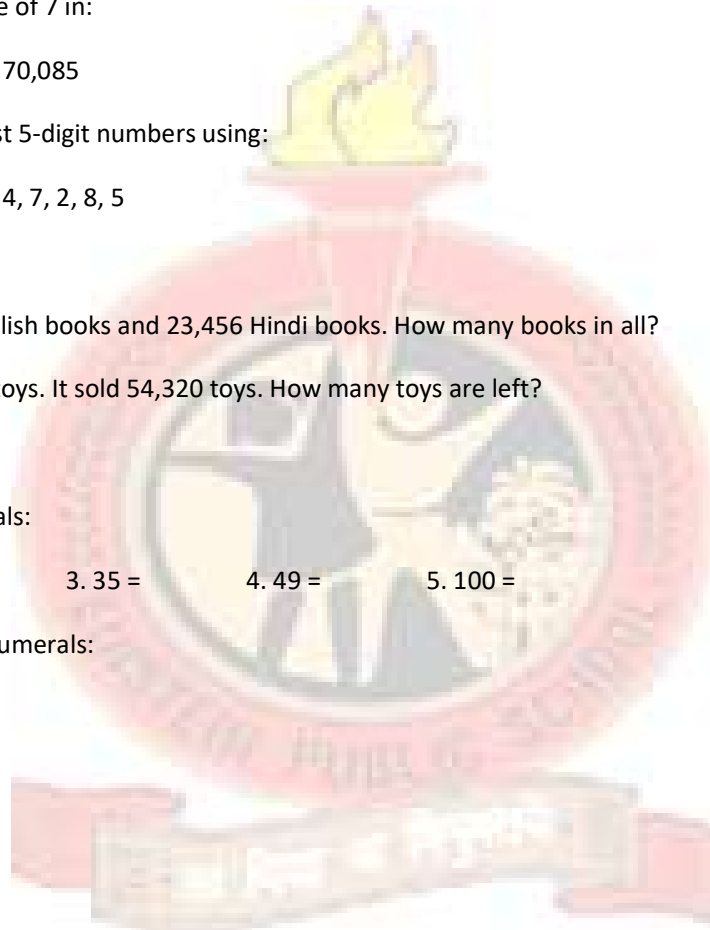
